Intersections is also screening the Singaporean-produced film **Iloilo**, on Saturday, 14 September 2013 at 7:00 pm.

Although not part of the Festival, NFSA will also be screening the 1975 Lino Brocka classic film, **Maynila: Sa mga Kuko ng Liwanag** (Manila in the Claws of Light) on 21 September 2013 at 4:40 pm.
